ADOPTION OF PUBLIC INTEREST ORDER -  
ARKVILLE WATER PROJECT.

BOND RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING INCREASE IN  
ARKVILLE WATER PROJECT.

The Town Board of the Town of Middletown, Delaware County, New York, held a Public Hearing and Special Meeting on Monday, August 15, 2011 at the Town Hall, located on State Route 28, Margaretville.

Supervisor Utter opened the Public Hearing at 7:05 p.m.

Supervisor Utter closed the Public Hearing at 8:05 p.m.

Supervisor Utter called the Special Meeting to order at 8:06 p.m.

Motion was made by B. Sweeney to adopt the ATTACHED Public Interest Order for the increase and improvement of the Arkville Water District. This motion was seconded by J. Rosa and carried by a vote of (4) ayes and (0) nays.

Motion was made by M. Finberg to adopt the ATTACHED Bond Resolution authorizing the issuance of an additional \$556,625 serial bonds to pay a portion of the cost of the increase and improvement of the facilities of Arkville Water District. This motion was seconded by B. Sweeney and carried by a vote of (4) ayes and (0) nays.

Motion for adjournment was made by J. Rosa and seconded by M. Finberg. This motion was carried by a vote of (4) ayes and (0) nays and the meeting was adjourned at 8:14 p.m.
