

RESOLUTION #2 OF 2014
A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE THIRD AMENDMENT TO AN
AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE TOWN OF MIDDLETOWN
& VILLAGE OF MARGARETVILLE REGARDING
BUILDING & ZONING INSPECTIONS

WHEREAS, by agreement dated July 17, 1990 (“Agreement”), the Town of Middletown (“Town”) and Village of Margaretville (“Village”) agreed that the Town’s Code Enforcement Officer, Building Inspector and Fire Inspector (“Town Inspector”) would perform Building Code and Zoning inspections on behalf of the Village; and

WHEREAS, the Agreement provides that the Village will pay compensation to the Town for such services by the Town Inspector; and

WHEREAS, in or about July 2002, the amount of such compensation was increased by amendment to the Agreement; and

WHEREAS, in or about April 2010, the amount of such compensation was increased by amendment to the Agreement; and

WHEREAS, in February of 2014, the Town does hereby resolve and approve the following further amendment to the Agreement:

1. “Section Three” of the Agreement, as amended is hereby deleted in its entirety and replaced by the following:

“SECTION THREE

FEES AND PAYMENTS

All fees from applicants for enforcement of the Building Code and Village and Town Zoning Ordinances shall be collected by the Town and shall be property of the Town. In addition, as compensation for the services provided by the Town Inspector to the Village, the Village shall pay the Town, on or about July 15 of each year, the sum of Ten thousand dollars.”

WHEREAS, all of the other provisions of the Agreement shall remain in force and this amendment shall not be effective until approved through resolution by the Town Board of the Town and Board of Trustees of the Village.

Now, therefore, be it resolved that the Town Board of the Town of Middletown does amend and approve the amendment.
