RESOLUTION NO. 3 OF 2016
RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN BOARD OF THE TOWN OF MIDDLETOWN DETERMINING THAT THERE ARE NO ADVERSE IMPACTS ON THE ENVIRONMENT FROM ADOPTION OF THE FLOOD DAMAGE PREVENTION LAW

WHEREAS, the Town Board is adopting a local law that repeals and supersedes Local Law No. 2 of the Year 2012 entitled “Flood Damage Protection Law” in order to maintain the community’s eligibility to participate in the National Flood Insurance Program (“NFIP”);

WHEREAS, the possible environmental impacts of the adoption of this Law have been considered by the Town Board;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Town Board has determined that the adoption of new Local Law No. 1 of the Year 2016 entitled “Flood Damage Prevention Law” will not have significant adverse impacts on the environment; and
