PUBLIC HEARING - ANSWER QUESTIONS AND  
REVIEW PROCEDURE FOR THE SUBMISSION OF A  
COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT FOR  
OWNER OCCUPIED HOME REPAIR IN THE TOWN  
OF MIDDLETOWN.

The Town Board of the Town of Middletown, Delaware County, New York, held a Public Hearing on Thursday, December 05, 2013 at the Town Hall, located on #42339 State Route 28, Margaretville, NY.

The following Board Members were present:

Supervisor Miller opened the Public Hearing at 4:00 p.m. The Town Clerk read the ATTACHED legal notice advertising the Public Hearings.

The Town Board discussed and reviewed the following changes to the Local Law No. 3 of 2013 - Ordinance for Operation and Control of the Arkville Water District - Town of Middletown, Delaware County, New York - Page 2 - Section 12 - Change forty (40) psi to seventy (70) and in the following sentence take out "no later than three years after the effective date of this Ordinance creating this three-year period of limitation."; Page 4 - Section 22 at the end add (See Appendix "A"); Section 33 - next to the last sentence after fitting, add "and/or material approved by the Water District Superintendent and under Appendix "A" add "4. There will be a Twenty-Five Dollars (\$25.00) fee for any and all returned checks paid to the District".

There were no questions or comments from the public, and Supervisor Miller closed the Hearing at 4:23 p.m.

Supervisor Miller opened the second Public Hearing at 4:23 p.m.

Peg Ellsworth stated that the Grant deadline was extended to January 17, 2014. She discussed the procedure for the submission of a Community Development Block Grant for owner occupied home repair in the Town of Middletown with the Town Board.

There were no questions or comments from the public, and Supervisor Miller closed the Hearing at 4:33 p.m.
