Motion was made by J. Rosa, seconded by J. Reischel to hold a monthly workshop meeting on the first Wednesday of each month except for the months of May, June and July and a regular monthly business meeting on the second Wednesday of each month for 2018 with meetings to be held at 6:00 p.m., at the Town Hall. John Mathiesen gave an update of the New Kingston Wastewater Management Project. He advised the Town Board that best location for a Community Wastewater leach field is on 10 acres of the Moriarity property. He felt if CWC purchased the entire property with the owner retaining his house and barn on 40 acres, after the project is completed, the Town would take possession of the remaining acreage to put on the market. After the sale, the money would go back to the program.

The Hog Mountain Committee reviewed their ATTACHED memo dated January 3, 2017 with the Town Board concerning Application for Special Permit for a Used Car Lot at 2224 Hog Mountain Road Tax Map #286.-1-12.712, submitted by Larisa Guselnikova.

The Town Board reviewed the ATTACHED Arkville-Halcottsville Water Monthly Action Report for December 2017 prepared by LVDV Operations.

Christopher Plante, Code Enforcement Officer addressed the Town Board to ask them to consider increasing the amount of the contract between the Village of Fleischmanns and the Town due to the increased activity and commercial permits. He also advised the Board that there is an issue in the Village of Fleischmanns. An appeal was commenced as to a decision that the zoning law was not followed for a building permit application and he asked for attorney's representation. The Town Board stated that they felt that was not necessary at this time but for him to go present his position as to his decision.

Motion was made by K. Taylor, seconded by B. Sweeney to appoint MegAnne Balcom as Assessor and Assessor Clerk from 01/03/18-12/31/18. (5) Ayes - Carl P. Davis; Jake Rosa; Brian Sweeney; Kenneth Taylor and Julia Reischel - (0) Nays.

The Town Board reviewed the ATTACHED letters from Hwy Supt John Biruk, informing the Board that he has appointed Michael R. Hill as Deputy Superintendent of Highways for a one year term and asked the Town Board to approve a raise of \$.55 per hour. Motion was made by J. Rosa, seconded by J. Reischel to accept this appointment and approve the raise of \$.55 at the rate of \$23.37 per hour. (5) - Ayes - Carl P.
