He called the Mark Project to confirm that he never received any money for the new roof on his bowling alley and since he will not be here next week, he is in full support of the Consulting Agreement with the Mark Project as it has helped many in the community.

Finberg to schedule a Public Hearing for Tuesday, January 24, 2017 at 5:00 p.m. to discuss the close-out of the Locality's Community Development Block Grant Project, CDBG Project #731HR50-13. Rosa to schedule a Public Hearing for Tuesday, January 24, 2017 at 5:15 p.m. to discuss and review the proposed 2017 Water Rate Increase for the Halcottsville Water District and the Arkville Water District. Supervisor Davis read the ATTACHED letter dated August 13, 2015 from former Supervisor Marjorie Miller to Bob Richter requesting "that State Route 30 be posted to direct truck traffic along County Route 38, taking truck traffic off of our narrow village downtown". Supervisor then read the ATTACHED letter dated December 9, 2016 from Tony Signorelli, Regional Traffic Engineer of NYS DOT stating "By means of this letter, we are asking you to consider the request as it impacts your highway system, adjacent residents and businesses. Further, we ask that you review the request at your Board meeting and submit an approval or disapproval to us in writing." Supervisor Davis advised the Town Board that he emailed both letters to Wayne Reynolds for his review. Wayne Reynolds sent the ATTACHED email dated January 03, 2017 stating "DPW is not in favor of this designation. As you know, we do not provide winter maintenance around the clock for budgetary reasons. But as long as it is a county road, we are not in favor of designating it as truck route. We do understand that Route 30 through Margaretville is tight for trucks but that we believe that problem is the State's to address. Not the County's to assume at full County Cost." Motion was anonymously made by. J. Rosa, seconded by M. Finberg not in favor of making County Route 38 a truck route. (5) Ayes - Carl P.
