

**RESOLUTION #5 of 2021**  
**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING "NO PARKING"**  
**SIGNS ON CUL-DE-SACS, TURNAROUNDS**  
**AND ANY TOWN ROAD AS NEEDED**

**WHEREAS**, the Town is responsible for maintenance of its roads, including snow removal, as necessary; and

**WHEREAS**, vehicles parked on cul-de-sacs, turnarounds, and along Town Roads at various locations through the Town have repeatedly prevented the Town Highway Department from timely and efficiently performing such maintenance; and

**WHEREAS**, despite repeated requests that vehicles not be parked on cul-de-sacs and designated turnarounds along any Town Road,

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Town Board of the Town of Middletown, Delaware County, New York, as follows:

"No Parking" signs shall be installed on cul-de-sacs, designated turnarounds and along any Town Road as needed. The Board delegates to the Town Highway Superintendent the determination about the number and frequency of such sign.


