RESOLUTION #6 OF 2021 RESOLUTION TO APPROVE TWO HOMES TO EXCEED THE BUDGET CAP OF \$24,500 PER HOUSEHOLD IN ORDER TO ADDRESS EMERGENCY AND NECESSARY REPAIRS

WHEREAS, the Town of Middletown is the recipient of a Community Development Block Grant for income eligible owner occupied home repair. The Town of Middletown set the budget cap of \$24,500 per household.

WHEREAS, two homes have come in over the Town allotted amount. One bid came in at \$29,040, but additional repairs had to be done to the electrical immediately, for the health and safety of the client and living conditions. Please approve the additional \$4,540 to complete this project.

In addition, we have one open spot that needs to be filled ASAP. We are requesting that the Board allows us to put the fifteenth spot towards Mendoza's project totaling two amounts of 24,500. The total of the project would be \$47,200 to bring it up to the code requirements.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that The Town of Middletown Board has agreed to increase the budget cap to \$29,040 for Schneider and \$47,200 for Mendoza in order to address these emergency and necessary repairs.
