The Town Board reviewed the ATTACHED contract provided by Cedarwood Engineers for the services as a contract water treatment plant operator for Halcottsville and Arkville Water District. Motion was made by R. Williams, seconded by C. Dabritz to approve the contract and to have an active discussion with the Village of Margaretville Mayor about using their licensed water operator. Davis said the water test only test for bacteria and not rust. Council Member N. Delameter agreed to speak with Halcottsville Fire Department about flushing out the system and seeing what results became of that and then go further from there.

Motion was made by N. Delameter, seconded by R. Williams to re-appoint Ernest Steiglehner to the Board of Assessment Review for the term of 10/01/2023-09/30/2028.
